



AG CENSUS COVER CROP INSIGHTS

Recently, the USDA released its 2017 Ag Census - the first since 2012. The survey lists everything ag related, including the practice of cover crops. In case you missed it, **cover crop acres have grown nationally from 10.3 Million in 2012 to 15.4 Million in 2017, or about 8% annually.** If this rate continues, **expect ~40 million cover crop acres by 2029** - most of that growth centered around the midwest and greater corn belt.
