SR 5130 chewings fescue is the culmination of years of cooperative research. SR 5130 traces its origins back to twelve clones selected for its improved turf performance, including color, density, stress and disease resistance. Further screening was done on the progeny of those clones for higher seed yield, color, and improved stress and disease resistance in the production environment.

USES: Shaded lawns, ground cover

IDENTIFICATION: Narrow-leaved, cool season perennial and creeping and/or bunch growth habit, found mostly in shaded areas. Leaves have folded vernation (stem) and a dull underside.

ESTABLISHMENT: Slow establisher like tall fescue. Ideal for shade.
